



## Tech Logic announces CircIT 2010 Self-Checkout Software

**WHITE BEAR LAKE, Minn. (Dec. 15, 2009)** – Tech Logic has released CircIT 2010, the next generation of the Minnesota-based company's powerful, flexible self-checkout software.

Tech Logic created CircIT – a dedicated Web server system that integrates with a library's automation system for self-checkout, circulation, reports, and RFID tag read/write functions – in early 2007. CircIT offers unlimited HTML customization options for patron screens, and it functions with RFID and barcode technology. CircIT Version 2 added "Instant Checkout," in which checkout and tag deactivation appeared on one screen using a color-code scheme that simplifies patron use, and "Hybrid Checkout," a simultaneous RFID tag and barcode checkout for the ultimate in patron convenience.

CircIT 2010 has been greatly enhanced with many features that improve the user experience, ease maintenance, and offer expanded functionality. Among CircIT 2010's new features:

- Remote Updates – Administrators receive update notifications and can download updates to the library's CircIT server. Once downloaded, restarting the software instantly deploys the updates to the CircIT terminals.
- Windowed Mode – allows library staff to run the application like any other Windows application.
- Wizard Installer – A step-by-step, easy-to-use guide for installing the client terminal and configuring hardware components.
- Monitor Memory – In dual-monitor environments, the application remembers its assigned monitor.
- Hardware Module Enhancement – The desensitizer/resensitizer hardware module allows the device to change the polarity of magnetic security strips on items.
- Receipt Display – Optionally display checkout receipts in a row or column format.
- Hold Pickup Date – Hold expiration dates can be printed on receipts if desired.
- Flexible Data Model Support – CircIT's adaptability is unsurpassed. CircIT's advanced design can support any data model.
